Town & Country Bank to relocate its office

ST. GEORGE — With construction of its new building nearly complete, locally-based Town & Country Bank will relocate its main banking and loan production offices to 405 E. St. George Blvd., today. The bank closed its old offices Friday to begin the transition.

“The new facility will allow us to better showcase our unique concierge banking model, where we offer full service, private banking-style delivery to all customers,” Bruce Jensen, Town & Country CEO, said. “We’ll also be more centrally located to our customers.”

Interior design of the new facility will not be finished until mid February, just ahead of the bank’s grand opening
